Malda (WB), Jun 9 (PTI) A 30-year old man died while travelling on a Shramik train from Alleppey in Kerala to Malda town on Tuesday, a government railway police official said here. The body of Khatip was taken off the train here and an unnatural death case was registered at the Malda town government railway police station, the official said.
